Theme: Shapes

Make shape art with your child using the supplies provided in this kit.

In your kit:

- Magnetic frame for your shape art
- Self-stick foam shapes
- Cardstock paper

As your child creates their art piece, ask them to name the different shapes. Once they are done, frame their work and put it on display!

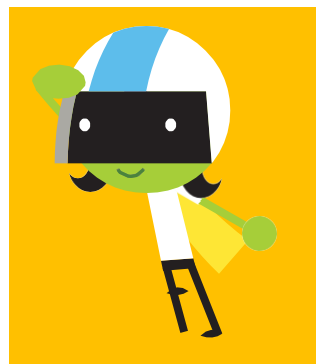

In your kit:

- Assorted pompoms
- Sorting tray
- Measuring tape
- Magnify glass



Sort the pompoms by size, color, or texture with your child! Ask them what they noticed about the materials their sorting.

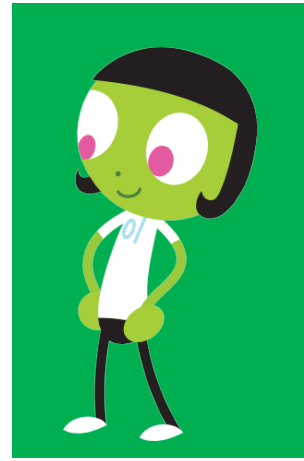

In this five senses activity kit, we have provided some starter materials for you, but feel free to find and use safe items from your home to continue the guessing game fun!

In your kit:

- Blindfold
- Yellow drawstring bag (to hide the guessing item)
- Play-dough – feel
- Small toy or eraser – see
- Bell – hearing
- Taste – lollipop
- Smell – scratch and sniff sticker



As you play ask your child to name the sense that they used to identify the item.

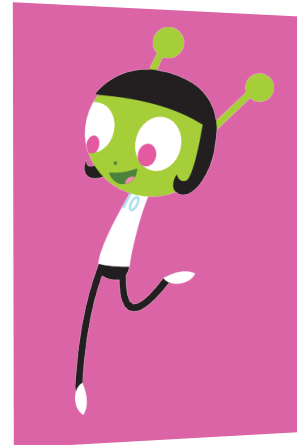
Dear Caregiver,

- Flashlight
