
Conversation Starters

- 1. Talk about your career with your child. Give them some ideas of why you chose it.
- 2. When out and about talk about the different jobs you see people doing, talk about what kind of qualities they have to make them good at the job.
- 3. Help your child make lists that summarize what they are good at, see if you can find jobs that need those qualities.
- 4. Talk about jobs that did not exist when you were a child. Ask your child what kinds of jobs they might need in the future we don't see now.





Write your questions about your dreams on these cards. Start with words like WHAT, HOW, WHY and WHEN. Then cut them out. Take them with you to the library to start your research about a career that is just right for you or to see how other people in your community got started making their dreams come true.
